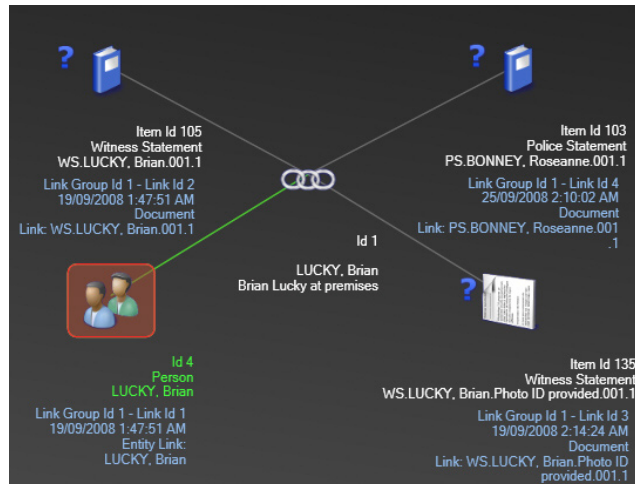
Eden is proud to announce the release of GEMS 3403 in September this year. This is the latest in a series of enhancements requested by our customers which offer a suite of new functionality. These include the OCR Text Hyperlinking and Graphic Links modules.

OCR Text Hyperlinking

This module further enhances the existing Optical Character Recognition (OCR) capabilities of GEMS by allowing users to create links between electronic documents. Users can select a hyperlink within a document which launches associated files such as images, videos or audio transcripts. This will significantly reduce the time required for users to familiarise themselves with a group of complimentary evidence. There is no limit to the number of hyperlinks which can be inserted into an electronic document.

Graphic Links

Creating links between GEMS data including entities, dates and documents can be a laborious process when large amounts of data are involved. The resultant output file can also be unwieldy to interpret when multiple links exist between these items. The GEMS Graphic Links module has been designed



to greatly enhance both the process of linking items and the resultant visual output. The Graphic Links module is fully integrated with the existing GEMS evidence matrix function to ensure users can easily make the transition to the new functionality.

The Graphic Links module will set the benchmark for all future GEMS development due

to its visual appeal and ease-of-use. This function will give users the ability to project multiple evidence matrices and their associated links and will greatly enhance group discussions and case progression. All existing evidence matrix functions have been incorporated allowing users to make changes “on-the-fly” utilising the flexible and intuitive features of this module.
